

Role profile: Ethics and Welfare Panel member

Purpose of role

To support Ethics and Welfare Panel to:

- Advise Policy Committee on ethical and welfare issues relating to policy development.
- Advise BVA working groups on ethical and welfare considerations and provide ongoing advice throughout the policy development process.
- Review draft policies to ensure appropriate consideration of ethical issues, first and foremost in relation to animal welfare.
- Review draft policies to ensure justifiable conclusions based on the available scientific evidence and ethical analysis.
- Horizon scan for issues of ethical and welfare related concern for consideration by Policy Committee.

Key responsibilities

- Contributing to discussions at meetings and via the online workspace.
- Reading papers in advance of meetings.
- Participating in three meetings per year (remote option available)
- Volunteering for occasional policy working groups dependent on areas of interest and expertise.
- Safeguarding and promoting the values of BVA at all times.

Knowledge, skills, and expertise

Vet members must be MRCVS and hold current BVA membership. Vet nurse members must be RVNs.

*** All members must have experience and/or qualifications in animal welfare science, ethics, or law and be up to date with new developments in approaches to these subjects***

Across the committee we are looking for a mix of experience and expertise, including:

- Committee experience
- Policy development skills and experience
- Strategic thinking
- Evidence gathering and research

- Analysis and evaluation
- Understanding of the current animal welfare and veterinary landscape
- Understanding of political and cultural climate in which BVA seeks to influence policy makers.
