

Role profile: Young Vet Network Rep (YVN Rep)

Purpose of role

To support YVN activities at a regional level:

- Raising awareness of YVN as part of BVA membership
- Act as a main point of contact for YVN in your local area
- Contribute to the retention of YV members across BVA by running regional and local activities to support wellbeing and continuous professional development

Key responsibilities

- Being the main point of contact for a named YVN Hub at meetings and via the online workspace.
- Coordinating at least 2 events per year (online or face to face)
- Participating in 4 rep meetings per year (remote option available)
- Preparing annual summary of activities for YVN end of year meeting
- Safeguarding and promoting the values of BVA at all times.

Knowledge, skills, and expertise

Members must be MRCVS and hold current BVA membership.

- Networking skills
- CPD development / programming
- Event management
